

## Single-Component Criteria for Joint Scoring in Rodent Arthritis Models

### ***Total Arthritis***

Measures: extent of inflammation, erosion, and repair across multiple joints

Assessed in: all joints within a given specimen (typically a paw)

0	Normal
1	Minimal disease (usually a focal lesion)
2	Mild disease (approximately 25 to 40% of joints involved)
3	Moderate disease (approximately 50% of joints involved)
4	Marked disease (approximately 60% to 70% of joints involved)
5	Severe disease (80% or more of joints involved)
